



Dear Business Week Students and Parents:

Due to a partnership with the Edmonds Community College, we are able to offer two elective college credits for students successfully completing the Business Week Summer Programs (including the Healthcare, Energy, Construction and Manufacturing pathways)! This is a great opportunity to get a jump start on college.

Edmonds Community College (EdCC) has created a specific course for the Business Week Programs worth two elective credits that may be applied toward Management, Healthcare, Construction, Energy and Manufacturing Degree options at EdCC (MGMT 155 for Business Week students, AHE 155 for Healthcare students, ENRGY 155 for Energy Week students, CONST 155 for Construction Week students, and CEN 155 for Get AMPT! students). They may also be recognized as elective credits at other colleges, however *it is up to each student to identify if and how credits will transfer to their intended college.*

All participants were able to benefit from a reduced tuition rate (the typical tuition for 2 credits is over \$190.00). These credits were optional, and the fee was in addition to Business Week's registration fee. These two college credits were earned by fully participating in any of our one-week programs. There were no additional tests or written papers required. The grade given was an "S" (satisfactory).

To register for college credit, you needed to complete the EdCC registration form you received just prior to your program and bring the form with you to check-in at your program. College Credit registration and payments could only be accepted up to one week after the week you attended.

If you registered for College Credit, you should have received directions in the fall from EdCC by mail about how to download your grade from the EdCC website. If you did not receive these instructions you can contact Pam LeMay at Edmonds Community College for help downloading your transcript.
