Business Week is back at Eatonville High School

Eatonville High School is partnering with Washington Business Week to bring a five day intensive business leadership program to nearly 150 students in April, 2010. For five full days, Eatonville High School students will have to opportunity to find out what it takes to be successful in the "real-world" of business and develop their passion and skills to help them become our business leaders of tomorrow.

This unique program partners the business community (over 50 volunteers) with educators to engage students in activities focused on free enterprise, ethics, leadership, teamwork, and other skills and knowledge critical for future success in any career.

During the week, students form companies (of 12- 15 members), establish norms, create a management team, develop a mission statement, determine a business strategy and plan, operate 8 quarters of a simulated business, make financial decisions, resolve ethical challenges with case studies, attend business related seminars, participate in team building activities, prepare a marketing and stockholder presentation, and produce a trade show.

Students finish the week having experienced basic economic and business concepts, developed critical thinking skills and problem solving strategies, and discovered the importance of teamwork. All of this while they learned more about others and themselves.
