## What is "Get AMPT! Week?"

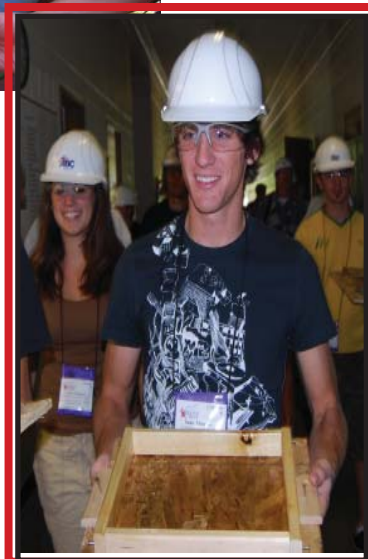
